## Exede Evolution Satellite Internet Launches in Missouri

### Innovative satellite Internet plan provides 12 Mbps service and unlimited, full-speed access for web pages and email

- Introductory offer that waives the initial set-up fee of \$149.99.
- Download speeds of up to 12 Mbps and upload speeds of up to 3 Mbps.
- Early Bird Free Zone, which provides full-speed, unmetered access to everything on the Internet, including video, from 3 a.m. to 8 a.m. daily.
- Introductory offer of award-winning anti-virus/anti-spyware software.
